Richard has a PhD in Geology (Part A: Middle-Late Cretaceous and Neogene calcareous nannofossil biostratigraphy of the Papuan Basin, Papua New Guinea; Part B: Calcareous nannofossil biostratigraphy and sediment accumulation of turbidite sequences on the Madeira Abyssal Plain, U. Western Australia, Perth, 1998) and a BSc in Geology (Biostratigraphy and sedimentary facies of the Cenomanian-Turonian Ieru Formation, Ok Tedi region, Papuan Basin, New Guinea, U. Western Australia, Perth, 1991).

He has expertise in Upper Triassic to Recent nannofossils and is also experienced in interpreting Australian Mesozoic palynological data. Richard joined the team in 2015, and is based in Western Australia, but has dual Australian/US citizenship. He brings 10 years of hydrocarbon industry experience, having worked in both Australia and the US.
